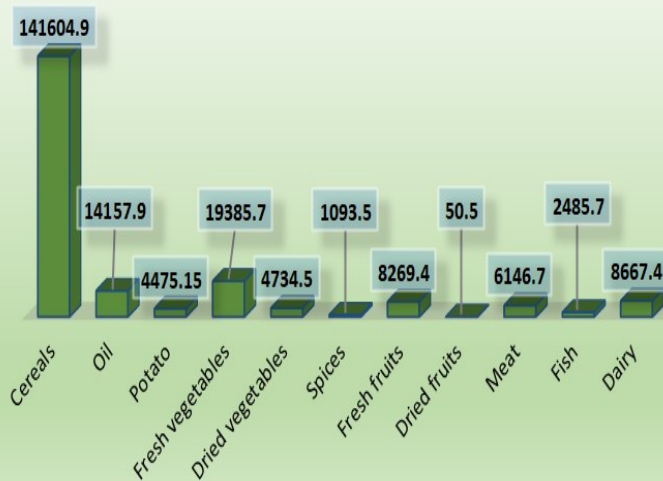




EXPORT AND IMPORT OF MAJOR RNR COMMODITIES 2022

Import of RNR commodities 2022

According to the Bhutan Trade Statistics published by Department of Revenue and Customs, Ministry of finance, Bhutan imported a total of 211071.35 metric tons (MT) of major RNR commodities worth Nu. 12893.5 million during the year 2022. Out of the total imports, cereals accounted for 67 percent. The cereals imported included rice, wheat, maize and buckwheat.

Among the cereals, rice was the major import commodity. Bhutan imported 112016 MT of rice worth Nu. 3654.22 million, along with other RNR commodities during the same year.

The total import volume of mentioned RNR commodities during 2022 increased by 7.8 per-

cent from 195839.2 MT in 2021 to 211071.4 MT in 2022.

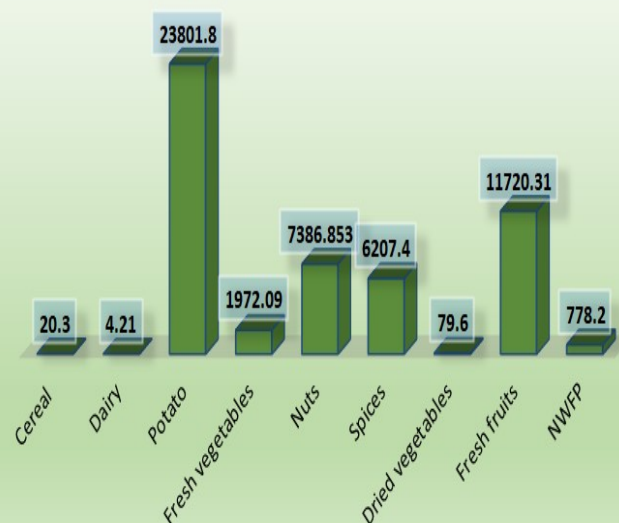
Export of RNR commodities in 2022

According to the Bhutan Trade Statistics, the RNR commodity exports for the year 2022 was 51970.76 metric tons (MT) worth Nu. 2733.2 million.

Based on the percentage of total exports, the major commodity was potatoes, accounting for approximately 46 percent of the total export volume. Other significant exports included fresh fruits (oranges) at approximately 22.5 percent and spices (primarily cardamom) at around 20.4 percent of the total export.

The total export volume of mentioned RNR commodities during 2022 decreased by 9 percent from 57229.8 MT in 2021 to 51970.8 MT in 2022
